# SFA Novena for Deceased Loved Ones



## We Need You. Your Deceased Loved Ones Need You. Please Join Us in this Parish-Wide Effort

You are invited to join us for a nine-day period of prayer for deceased loved ones, who have gone before us, marked with the sign of faith. As Catholics we pray for those who precede us in death knowing that some have not yet entered the “Church Triumphant” in Heaven, but may be among the “Church Suffering” in Purgatory. Those in Purgatory, who are being purified for entry into Heaven, cannot pray for themselves. We, the “Church Militant,” must pray for them. For this reason the Church offers a period of indulgence from October 31st through November 8th to pray for those in Purgatory to be set free into the eternal kingdom.

We need you. Your loved ones need you!. All of our combined efforts during this Novena can lessen... or even immediately end... the balance of their suffering by successfully receiving a plenary indulgence on their behalf, through our offering.

To this end, St. Francis of Assisi Parish is offering a Novena of indulgenced prayers and works on behalf of our deceased loved ones. In order to be “fully disposed” to receive a plenary indulgence for our loved ones, we must prepare ourselves in four ways:

- Sacramental Confession at least once, in the 7 days prior to the Novena;
- Eucharistic Communion on the day of the indulgenced work;
- Prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father on the day of the indulgenced work;
- Freedom from all attachment to sin.

All of these conditions will be offered and made available to you during the Novena. A complete explanation of this discipline within the Church will be given on the first day of the Novena, Monday, October 31st, 2022, immediately following the 5:30 PM Mass.



# SFA Novena for Deceased Loved Ones



Indulgenced prayers and works are defined by the “Manual of Indulgences,” published by the Vatican. It teaches there are five (5) plenary indulgences that can be offered for those who have gone before us, during this Novena.

- A. Devoutly visit a Catholic cemetery any day from 11/1/22 - 11/8/22
- B. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for at least 30 minutes
- C. Recitation of the Holy Rosary in front of the Blessed Sacrament
- D. Participation in the Stations of the Cross in front of the Blessed Sacrament
- E. Scriptural meditation for at least 30 minutes

Each of the above works for a plenary indulgence can be offered for the benefit of a deceased loved one. As a parish, we will celebrate each of these prayers or works within this Novena at the times designated below. Remember... you must be “fully disposed,” as explained previously.
