Please read this document carefully before signing. All references to technology, its use, and access refer to technology owned or provided by the Catholic Diocese of Wichita, Kansas.

I promise:

- to act responsibly when using technology since it is a privilege and not a right.
- to only use technology at school when there is adult supervision.
- to use the recommended secure password.
- to not share my passwords with anyone except parents, teachers or administrators.
- to use technology in a way that follows Catholic teachings.
- to remember that not everything on the Internet is true.
- to only use websites and apps that a teacher has assigned to me.
- that if I see something inappropriate or makes me feel uncomfortable on a device, I will tell a teacher right away.

I will not:

- use technology to be unkind to others.
- look at or search for materials that do not follow the teachings of the Catholic Church.
- ask others to share their passwords with me.
- make changes to devices that I am using.
- download anything without a teacher's permission.
- use any device without permission.
- use someone else's username and password.
- damage the school's equipment, and if I accidentally do, I will inform a teacher immediately.

I will abide by the above Acceptable Use of Technology Policy for Students. I understand that should I violate the regulations above, my access privileges may be revoked and disciplinary and legal action may be taken.
