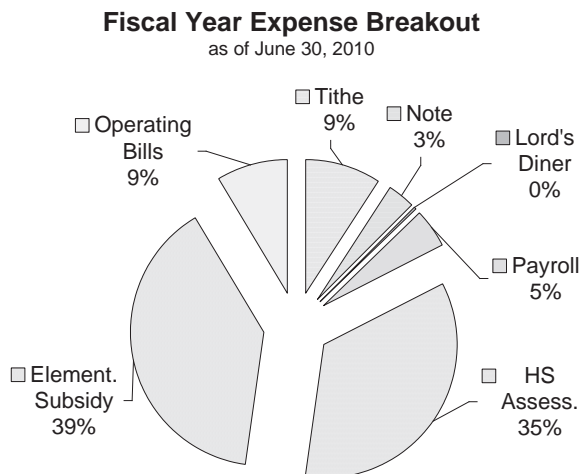
With our annual parish finance report taking place this year, I thought I would also share with you some comparisons of our contributions and our expenses.

Our regular Sunday contributions for the fiscal year 2009 – 2010 were just over 4.2 million. Our parish family is now just over 2800 households. The contributions by these 2800 households in 2009 were as follows:

- 35% of the households contributed \$0 recordable contributions
- 23% of the households contributed less then \$500
- 8% of the households contributed between \$500 and \$1000
- 20% of the households contributed between \$1000 and \$3000
- 14% of the households contributed \$3000 or more

The average income in 2009 in our parish is \$68,000. The average contribution in our parish was \$1,353, an average of less than 2% per family.

The contributions of our parish family used to fulfill our budget needs for the year are seen in the following chart:



As we begin our new fiscal year, I invite you to prayerfully consider the call of our Lord to reach the goal of a 10% return to the Lord for all he has given to us. If you are not at the standard set by our Lord, seek to make an increase of your return to him. God loves a cheerful giver and will not be outdone in generosity. With your faithful stewardship of your treasure, we can fulfill all our needs. May God bless you as you commit to giving a planned, proportionate and sacrificial return.
