

St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School Catholic School Activities League Rules and Expectations – Student Contract

All students who are members of any St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School sporting events understand that being part of this team is a tremendous commitment and dedication to the game and their team. Playing for the Vikings is a privilege and not a right. As St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School students, we understand and agree to follow the contract.

Player Responsibilities

- 1. I ________, hereby state that in the event of a scheduling conflict between an SFA sport and an outside organized sport / event, I must notify my coach of any conflict at the beginning of the season or a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the conflict, thus giving the coach time to work with the Athletic Director/s to find a floater/s to help my team out during my absence.
 - a. In the event that I choose to participate in the outside activity over my SFA sport, I may not start the next game, and/or my playing time may be affected depending on the coach's choice.
- 2. Any player joining a CSAL team must do so before the first scheduled game of the regular season. The only exception to this rule would be a student transferring from another school.
- 3. Attendance at all practices, team meetings, and games is mandatory. Injured players are still expected to come to practice and games, listen to coaches and encourage their teammates.
- 4. Only students who have attended school for half of the day (7:50-11:30 or 11:30-3:30) will be allowed to practice or participate in games.
- 5. In very rare situations, players may be excused from attending practices and games for emergencies, or if a player tells a coach via phone or verbally at the earliest possible time.
- 6. When a player misses practice, he/she will lose playing time in the next game. Players are to be on time to all practices and games, if this becomes a problem, they could lose playing time.
- 7. In the case of unexcused absences in which the coach was not informed in the manner described above, and/or the reason for the absence is not satisfactory, this may result in reduced playing time or other consequences as deemed appropriate.
- 8. Players are responsible for seeking understanding or resolution to a problem or question when they arise with coaches or teammates.
- 9. Players will stay eligible, understanding that if they are ineligible two weeks throughout the season they will be required to attend homework club for the remainder of that quarter.
- 10. The above standards do not preclude the authority of the principal to limit, suspend, or prohibit students from participation in practice or games for behavioral problems as they deem necessary.
- 11. Players will conduct their personal lives in a manner that brings honor to themselves, their team and school. This includes social media and other school activities.
- 12. Any athlete ejected from a game for unsportsmanlike activity will be suspended for the next game.

Eligibility

Students will be ineligible:

- Receiving a failing grade "F" Ineligibility lasts one week (Monday to Monday); that also includes Monday night games as well. Students are still allowed to practice with team and attend games. However, students are NOT allowed to play or suit up.
 - Students will have until 2:00 p.m. every Monday, during the grade check period, to raise their grade to a passing one. If it isn't passing by then, they are ineligible for that week.
 - o If you receive two consecutive "F's" in the same quarter, you will be required to attend Homework Club until the end of the quarter.
 - o If you have concerns that you are going to be ineligible, **please check PowerSchool** and see what needs to be turned in BEFORE grade checks on Monday.

- After 5th demerit Students who are ineligible will have a maximum suspension of one game.
- ISS or OSS Policy
 - o If a student receives an ISS or OSS, they are not allowed to either practice or participate in any CSAL athletic event for one week.

Game Day Protocol

- 1. All games are deemed mandatory. If a player must miss, they need to clear it with a coach beforehand.
- 2. Parents will make sure that if a student is going to be late to school, leave in the middle, or not attend for any reason they need to contact the school before 8:30 a.m. that day, or the student athlete will not be able to participate in practice or games that day.
- 3. Players that are released early from school are expected to get what they will miss from teachers.

Uniforms

- 1. Are to be kept clean and washed after every game.
 - a. Uniforms should be washed in cold water and on the gentle cycle the hang them to dry.
 - b. DO NOT PUT IN THE DRYER PLEASE.
- 2. The uniform is given to the player only; therefore no one else should be wearing it.
 - a. If the uniform is damaged or lost, the player/parents will be responsible to pay for a replacement.

I understand that in order for me to participate on a St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School team in football, volleyball, basketball, track, cheerleading, cross country or wrestling. I agree to the above rules and any rules as outlined by SFA

- 3. When the season is over, uniforms must be returned.
 - a. If the uniform is not turned in or is ruined from improper care, there will be a \$50 charge to replace that uniform.
